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**Summary:**

The purpose of this research study is to see how safe and how well a topical gel containing a new drug works to treat moderate or severe facial acne.

If you qualify to be in this study, you will be randomly assigned by chance to one of three study groups:

- 1% BPX-01 gel
- 2 % BPX-01 gel
- or vehicle

**Criteria for Participation:**

- Ages 9-40
- Are in general good health
- Have acne on your face
